Its flagship brand is LumiBridge, which markets LED lighting products in the UK, Germany, The Netherlands and Belgium. The company is headquartered in Leuven, Belgium. It has three factories in Brussels, Belgium, in Bern, Switzerland and in Guangzhou, China. Hauff Electronic is a member of the Euroluce group of companies. The company is a member of the International Lighting Association (ILA) and the Lighting Research Center (LRC). History Early days (2000-2008) Hauff Electronic Group was founded in 2000. Initially, the company's products were designed for lumiBridge, a subsidiary of Hauff Electronic. After the buyout of Hauff Electronic by the Swatch Group in 2007, the entire lumiBridge product line was transferred to the parent company. The group had its beginnings in a partnership between Hubert Hauff and Pierre D'Haeseleer, who started the company in Leuven, Belgium. In 2004, the two men parted ways, after which Hubert Hauff returned to the role of shareholder and CEO of the company. In 2006, the company acquired the rights to manufacture LED luminaires and lighting products for Armincom (a subsidiary of the Swatch Group) in Europe, with the Armincom name being used until 2013. In 2007, a research and development center was opened in Basel, Switzerland. In the same year, Hauff Electronic also launched lumiBridge.nl, the first Dutch distributor for lumiBridge products. The same year, the company also signed a contract to supply the world's largest solar park with LED luminaires. The Swatch Group takeover (2008-2010) In 2008, the Swatch Group bought up a majority of the company's shares. The company was thus taken over by its largest shareholder and subsequently renamed as Hauff Electronic Group. On 30 May 2008, the company signed a distribution agreement with the building products company CRH Holding AG for Europe, the Middle East and Africa. The company sold its first lumiBridge luminaires to CRH in 2009. In 2008, the company also launched lumiFlame, a network of LED luminaires designed to offer customers flexibility and optimized design solutions.
